



Did you know?

A sewerage treatment plant upgrade improves water quality. Maisy feels great!

The river dries up in a drought and Maisy feels sick

Mayfly nymphs are small bugs that live in the water and can be very sensitive to changes in their aquatic homes. This makes them a good indicator of waterway health.

How
to Play

1. Roll a dice to decide playing order - highest number rolls first, lowest rolls last.
2. Place a token for each person on the starting block.
3. Take turns to roll the dice and move your token the number of places shown on your roll.

If you land on a **RED ARROW** - slide backwards to the place shown.

If you land on **GREEN ARROW** - move forward to the place shown.
